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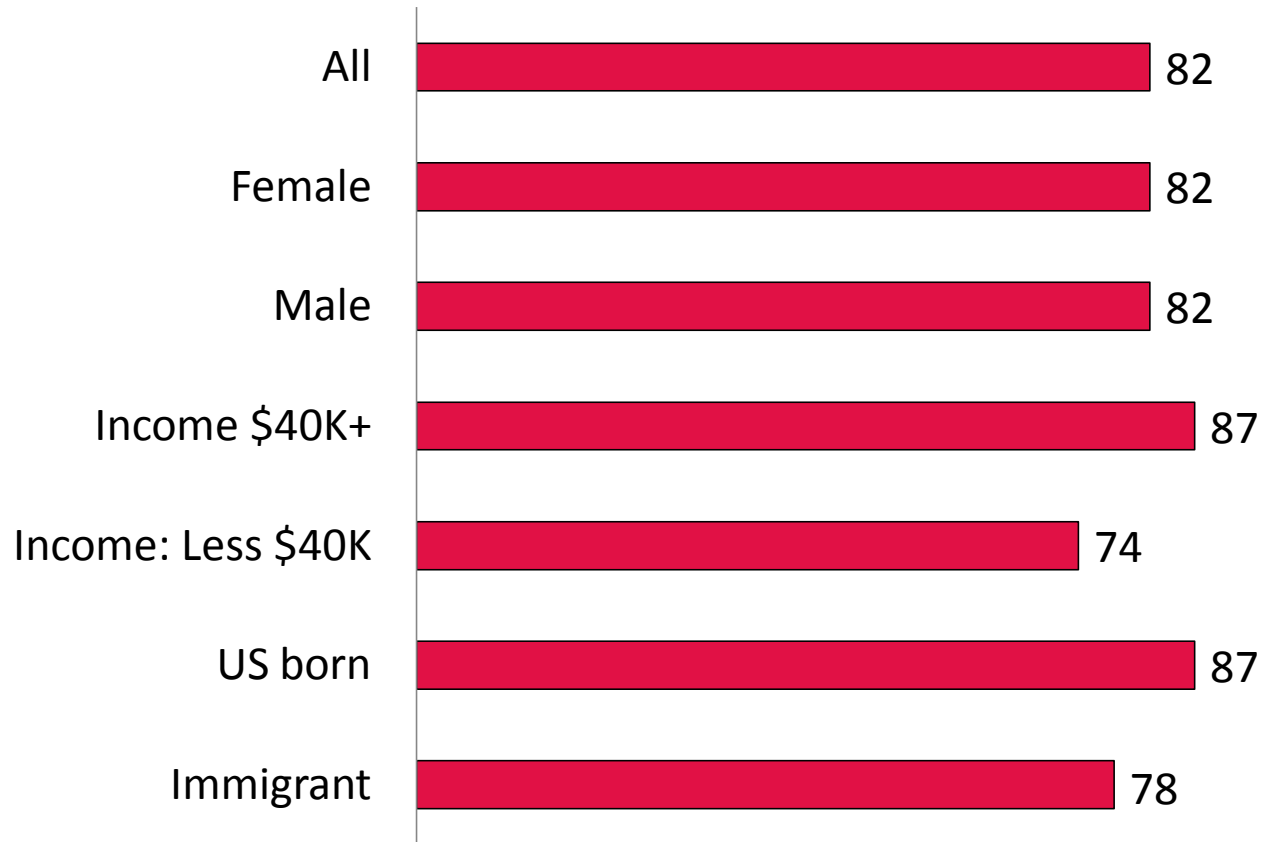
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Impact of the ACA on Latino Community

Do you currently have health insurance coverage?

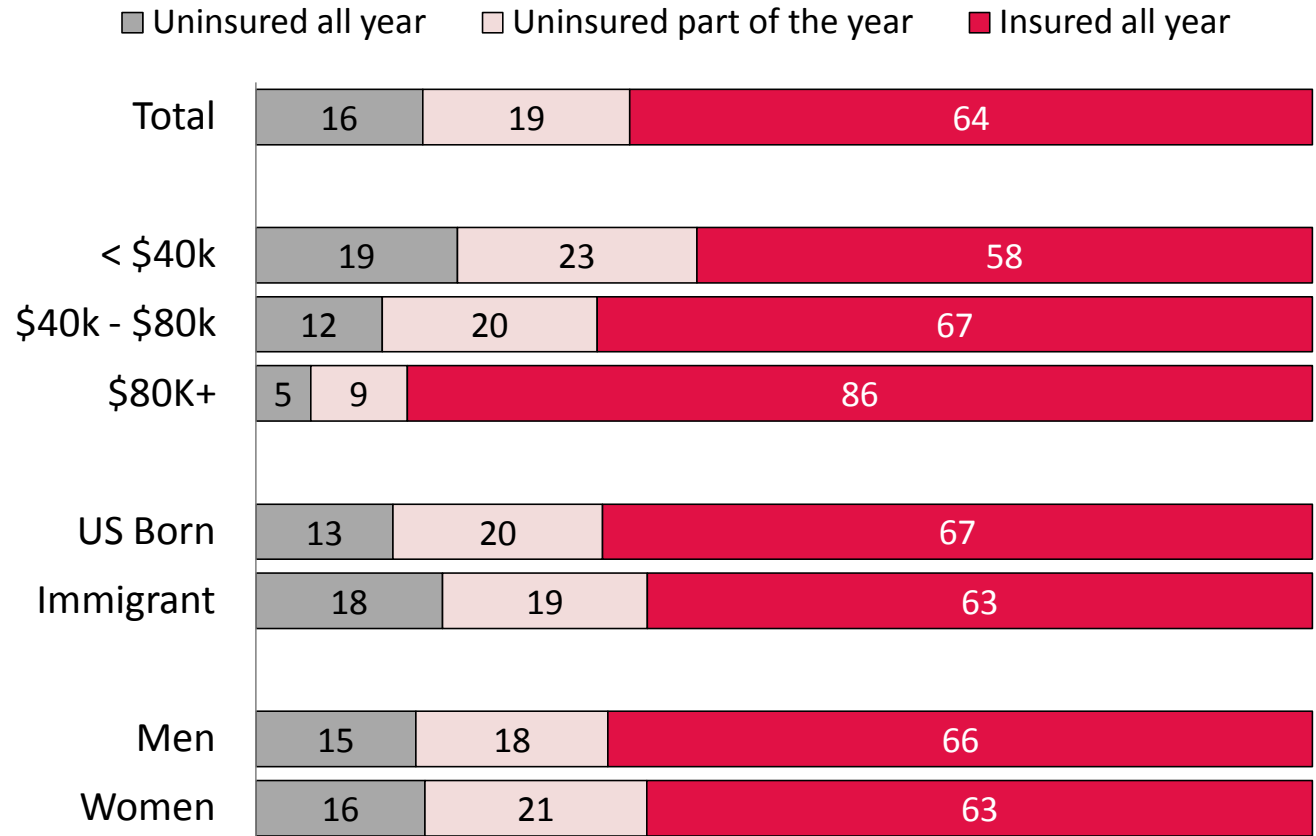

At any time over the last 12 months, did you ever go without health insurance, even for a few weeks or months, or did you have health insurance throughout the entire time?



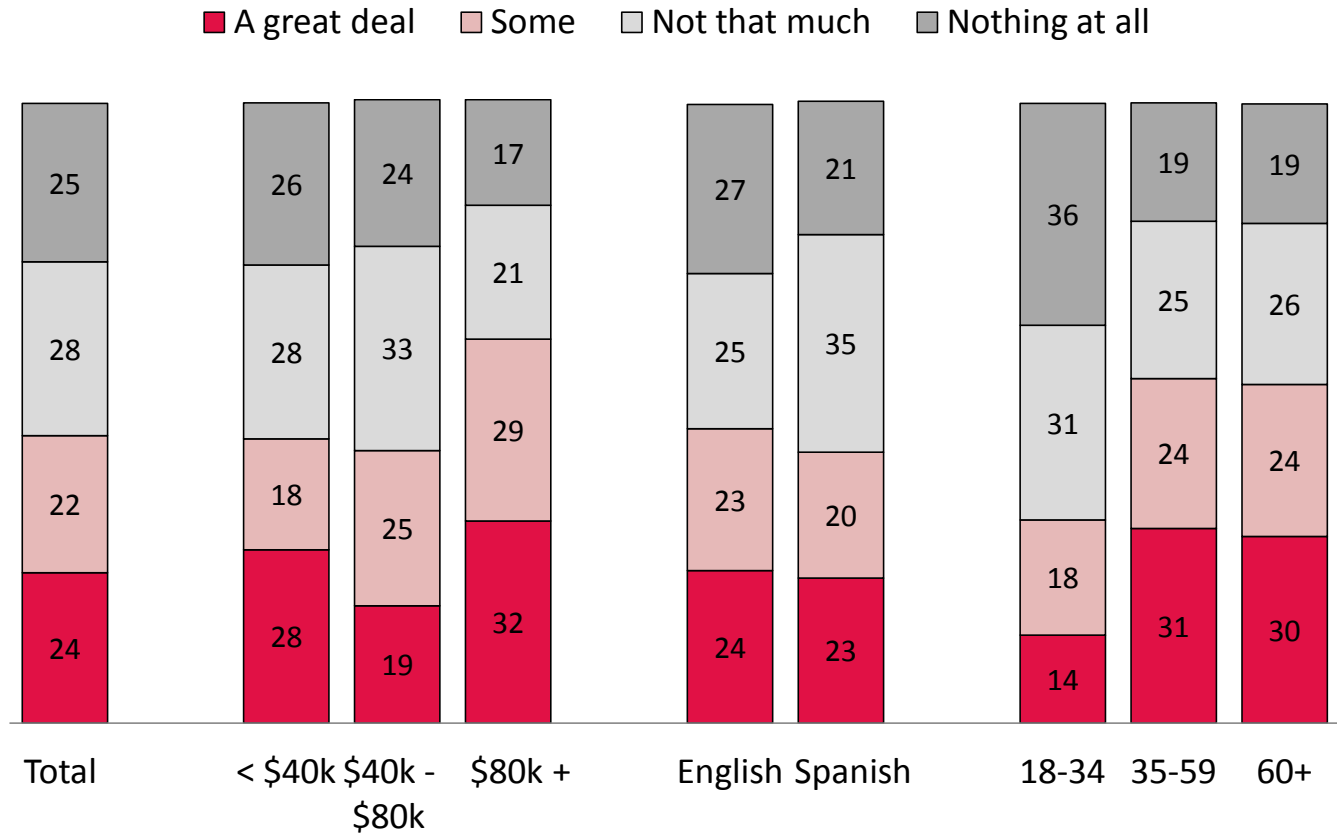

How much have you heard or read about the new health insurance marketplace?

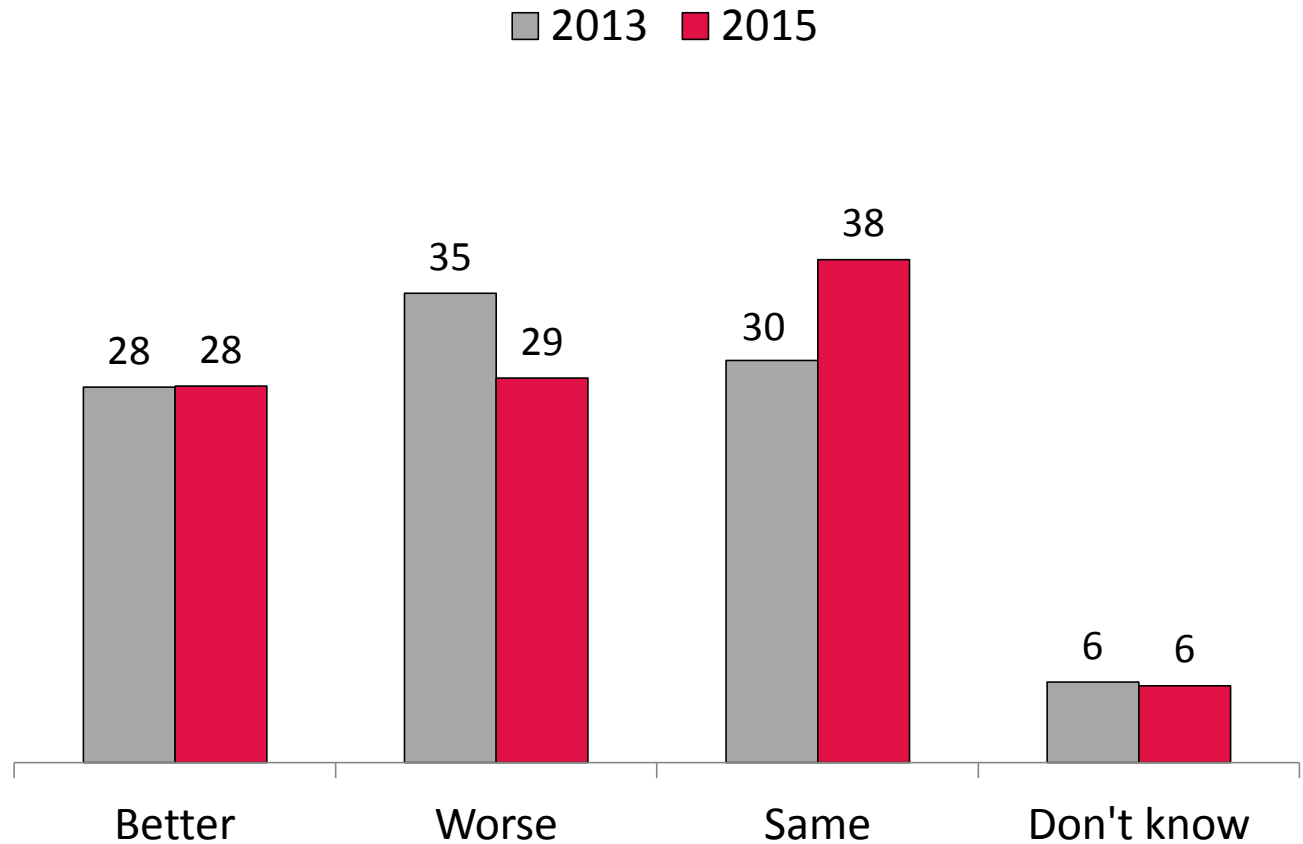

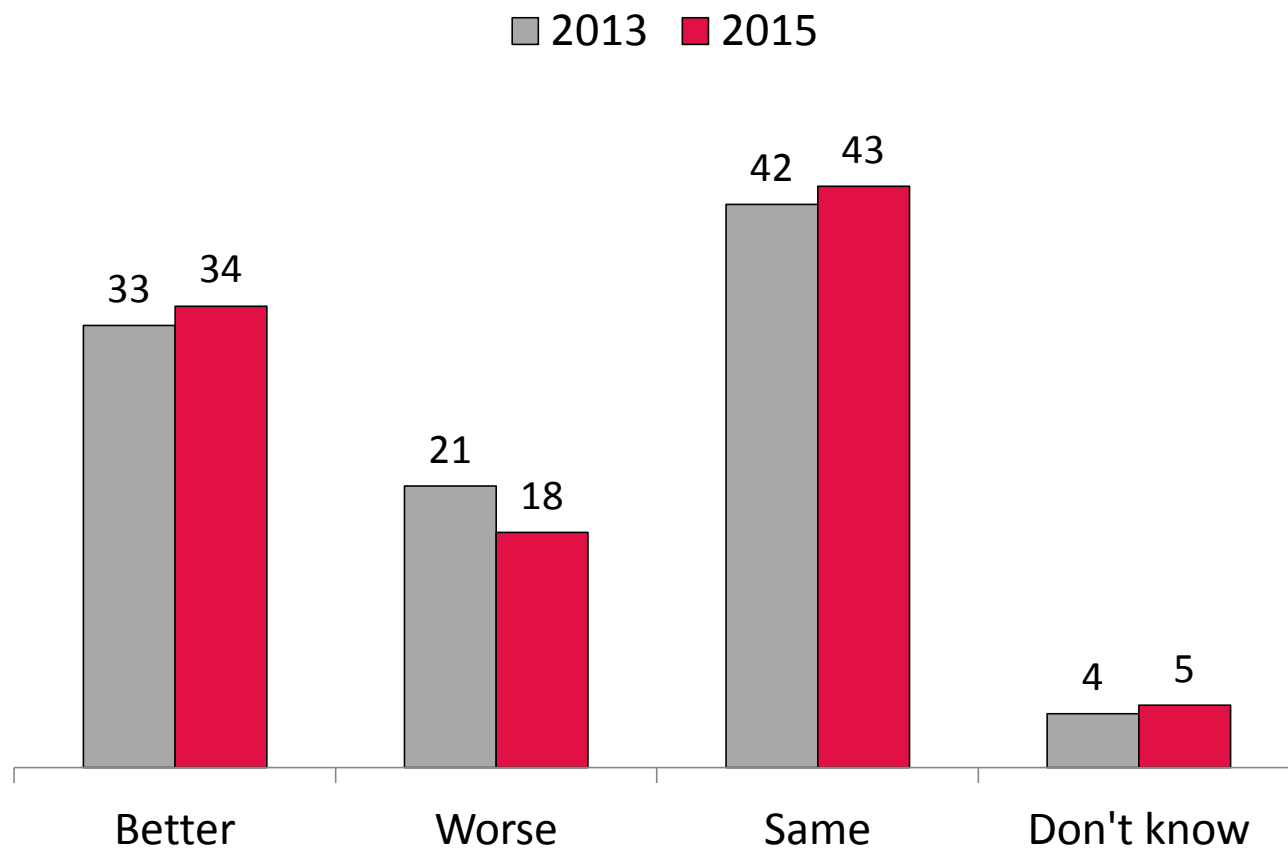

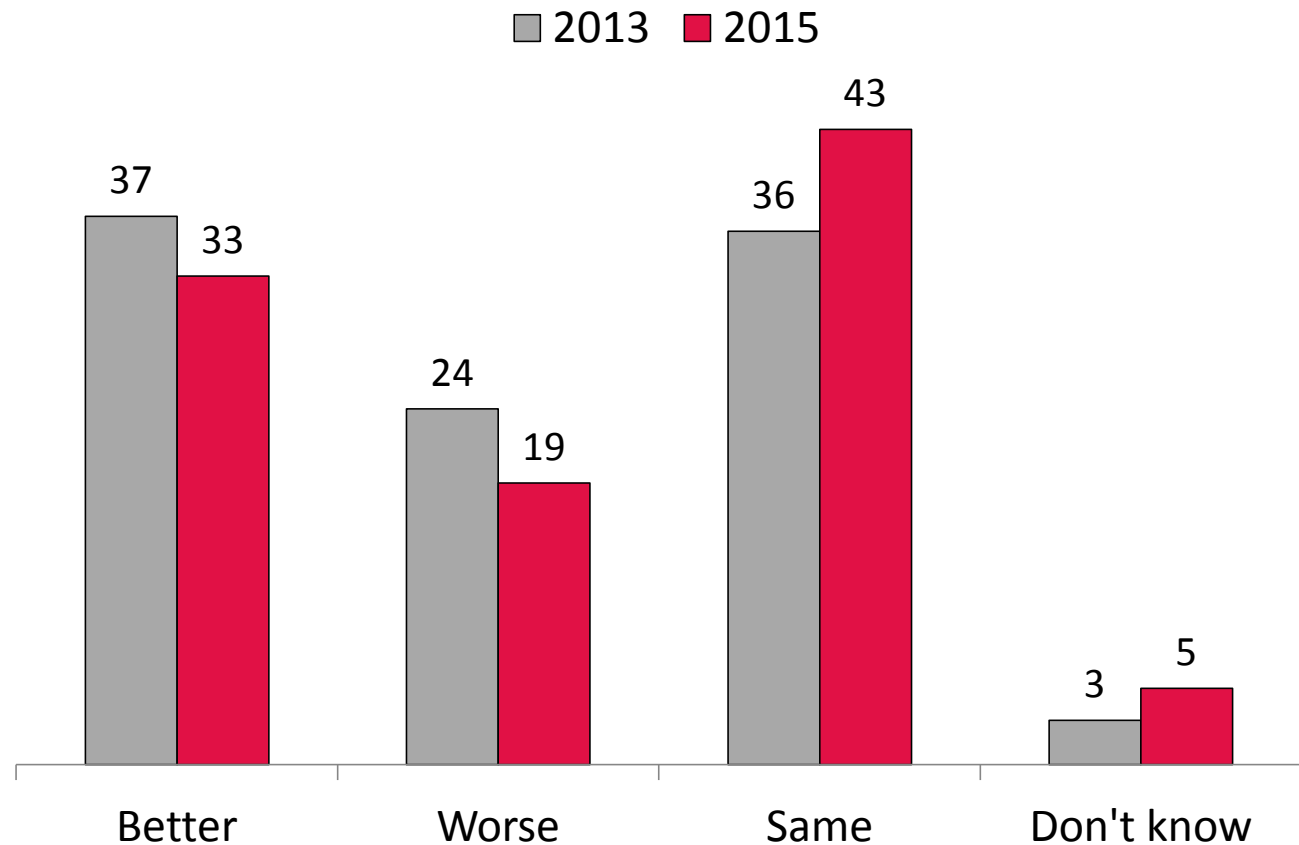

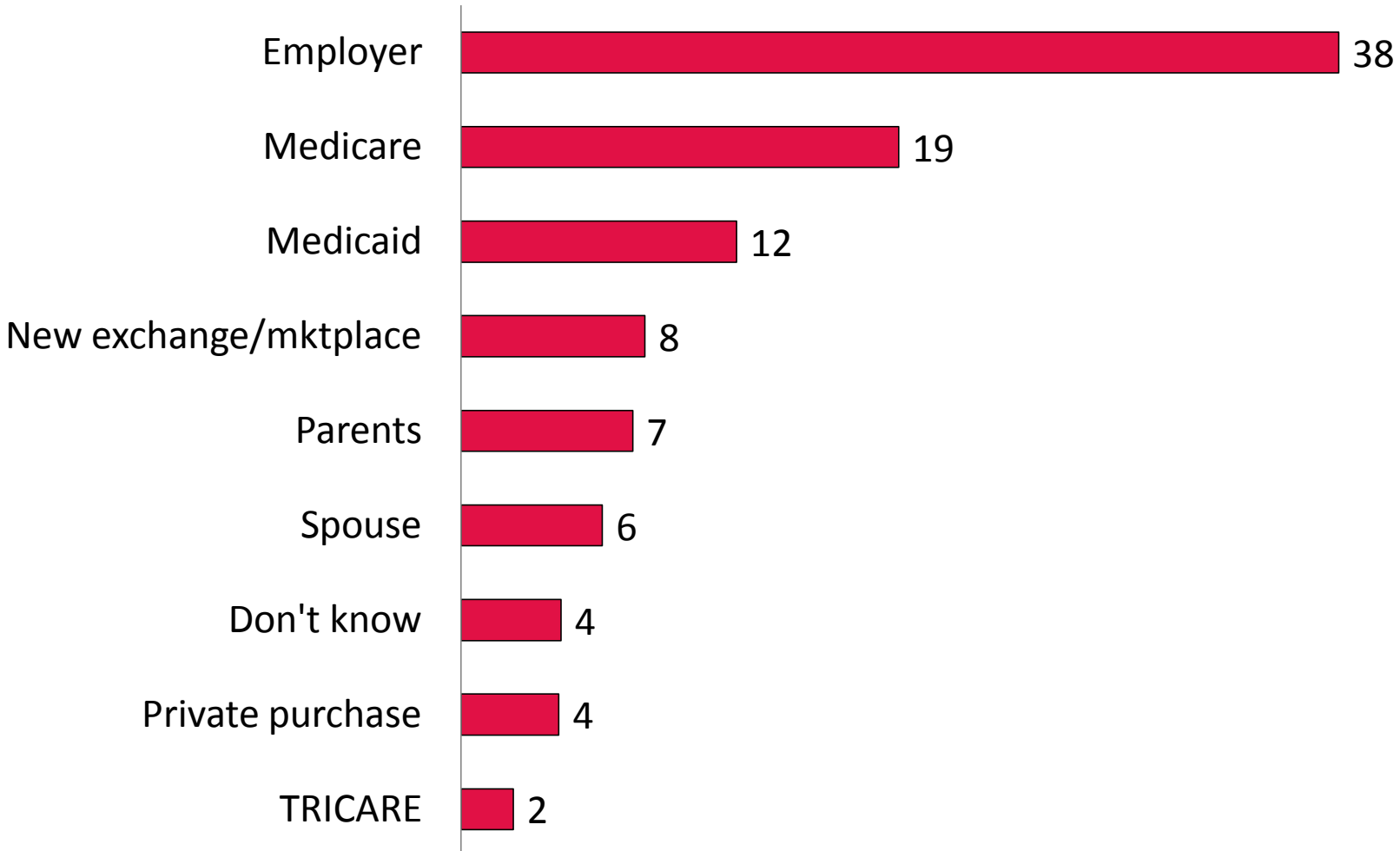
Thinking about health care reform, do you think your ability to get and keep health insurance will get better, worse or will it stay about the same?

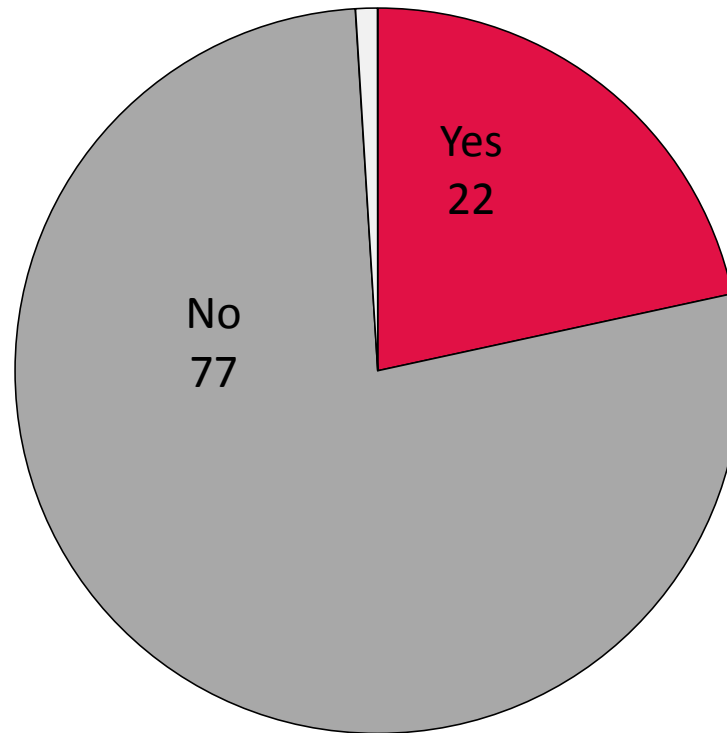

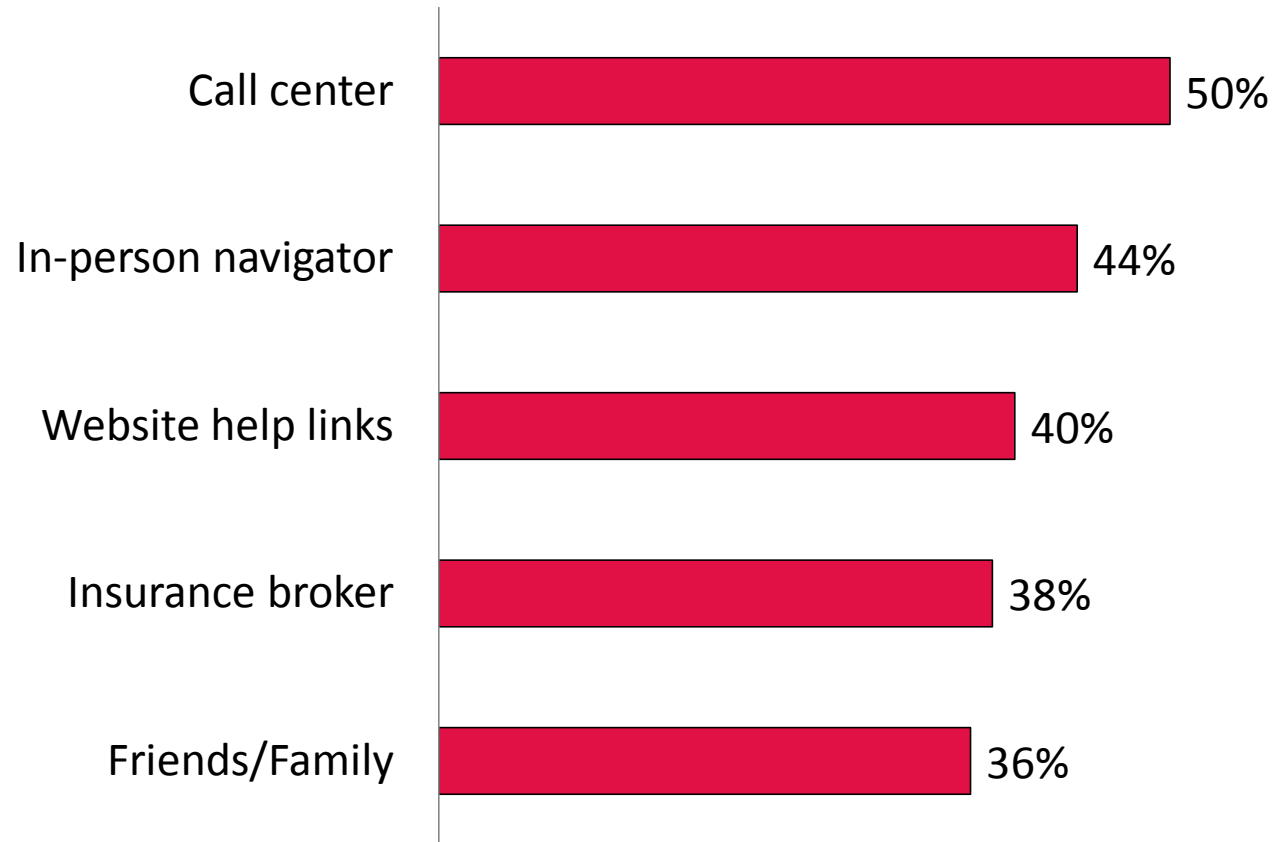

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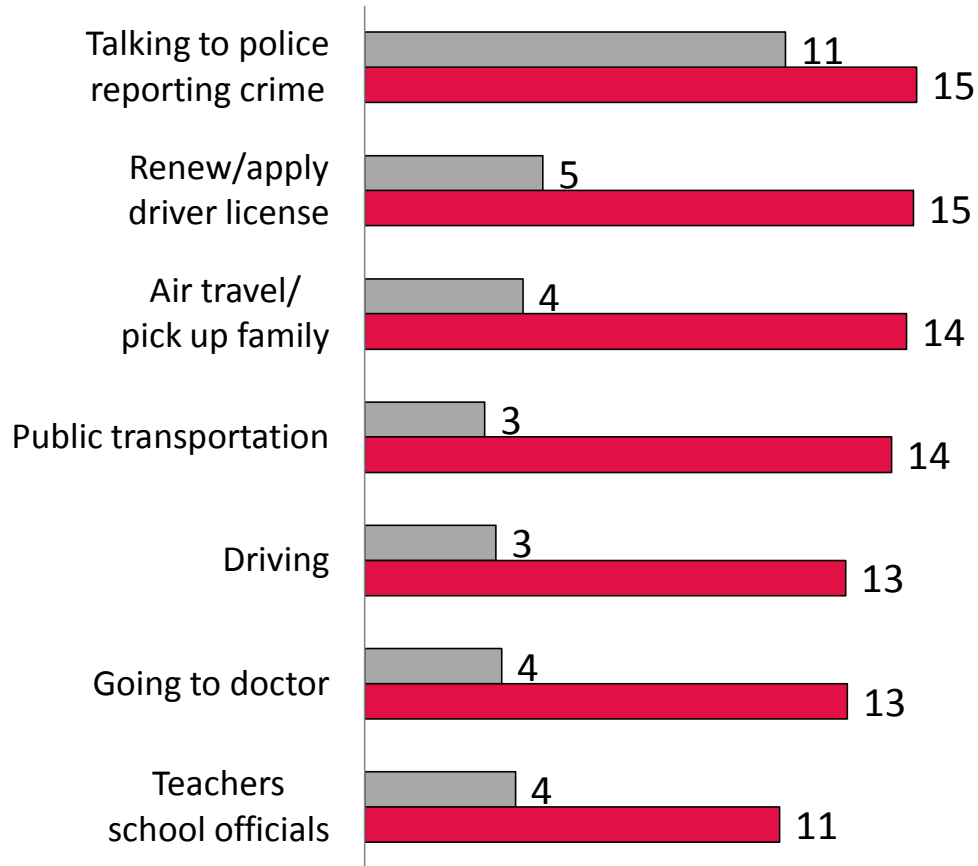

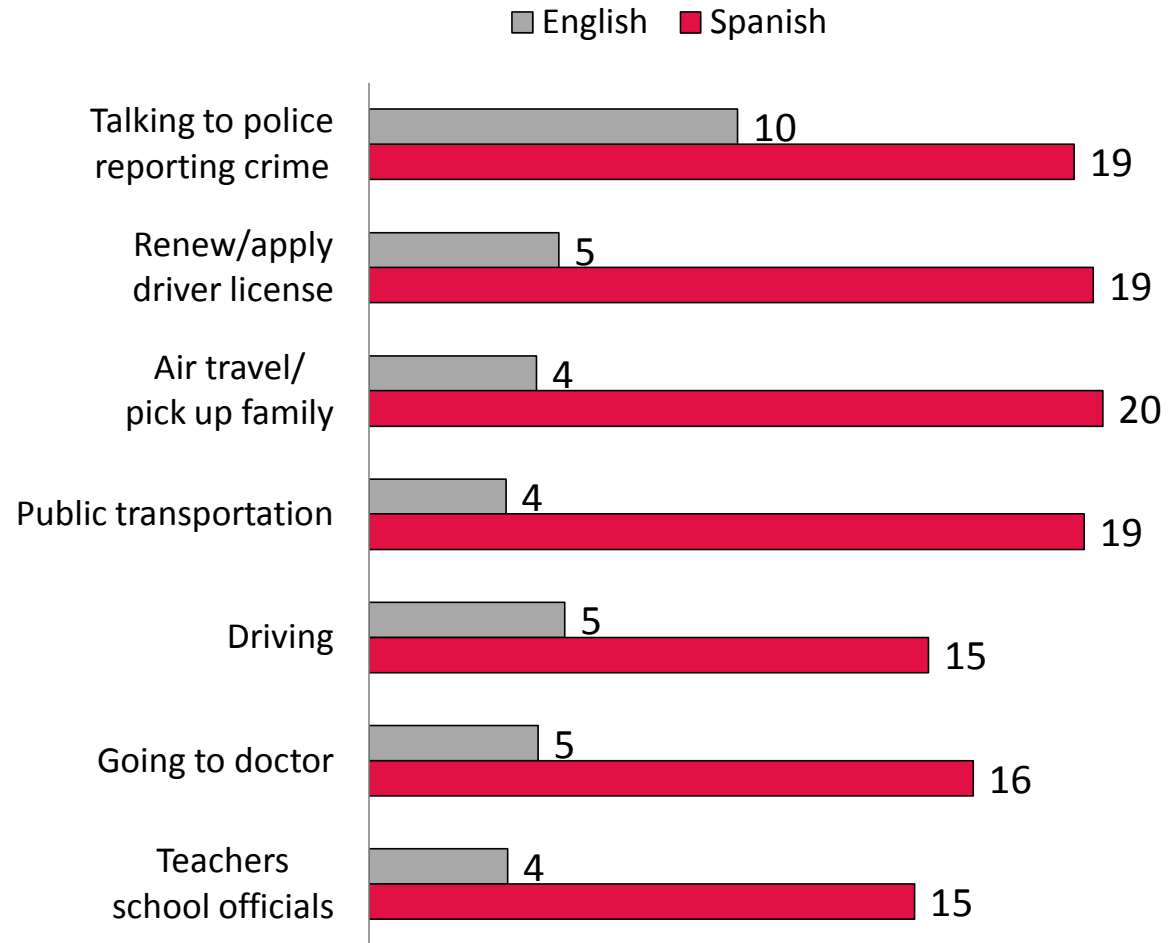

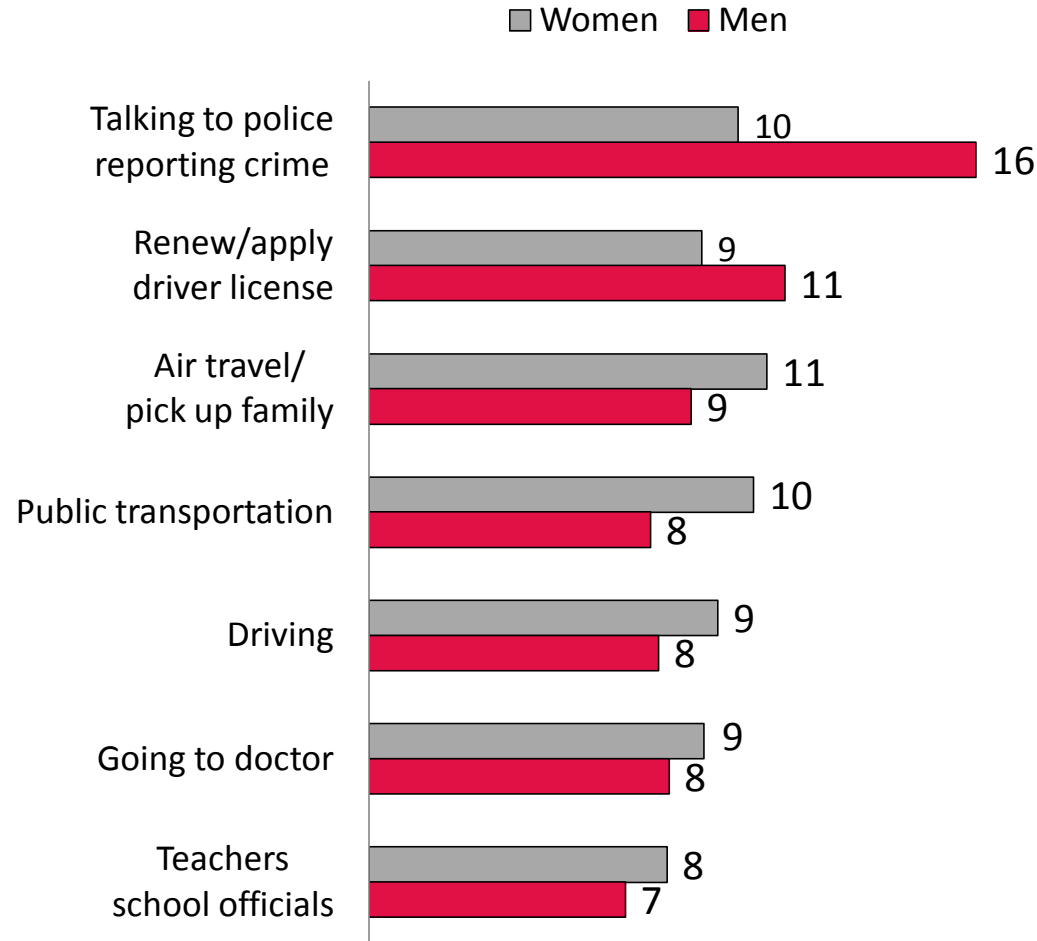

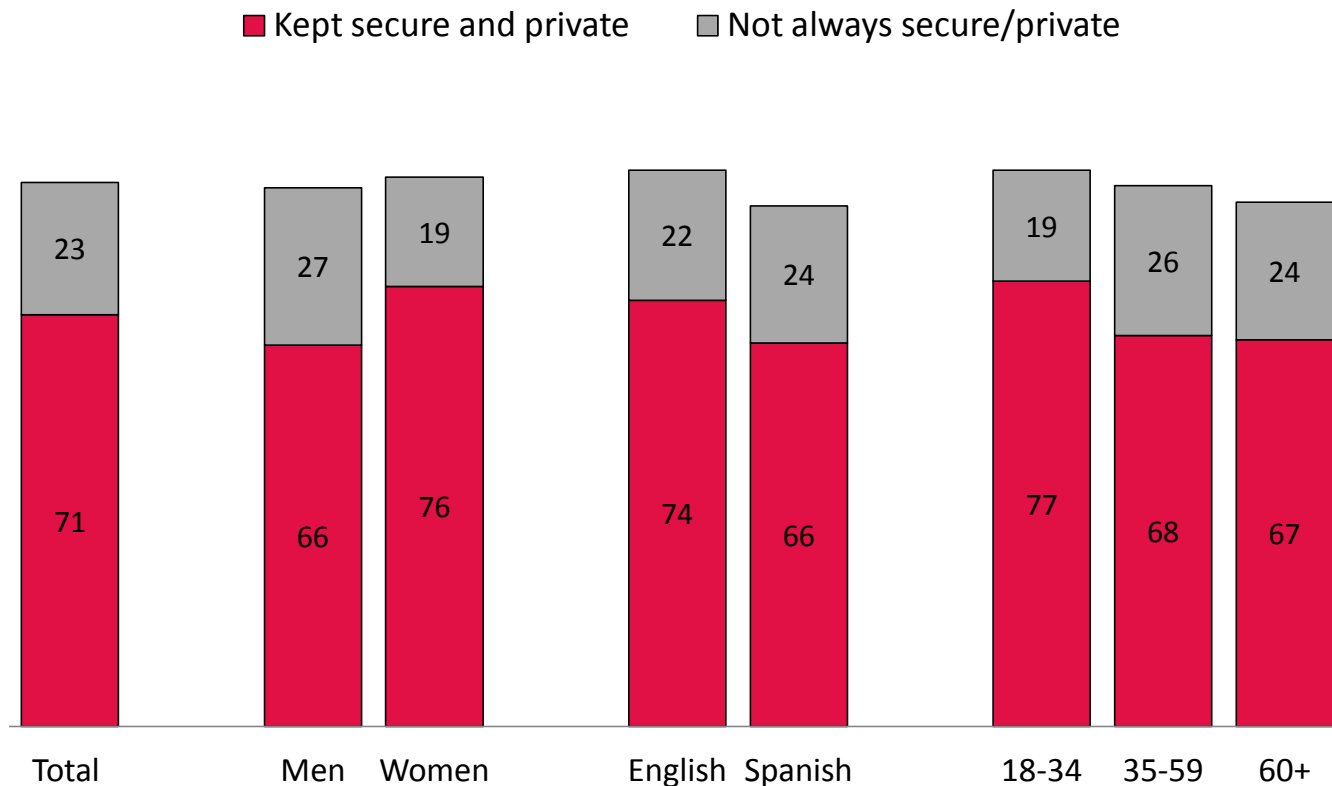

2) Personal information I provide to my doctor and health care providers is sometimes shared and not always secure.



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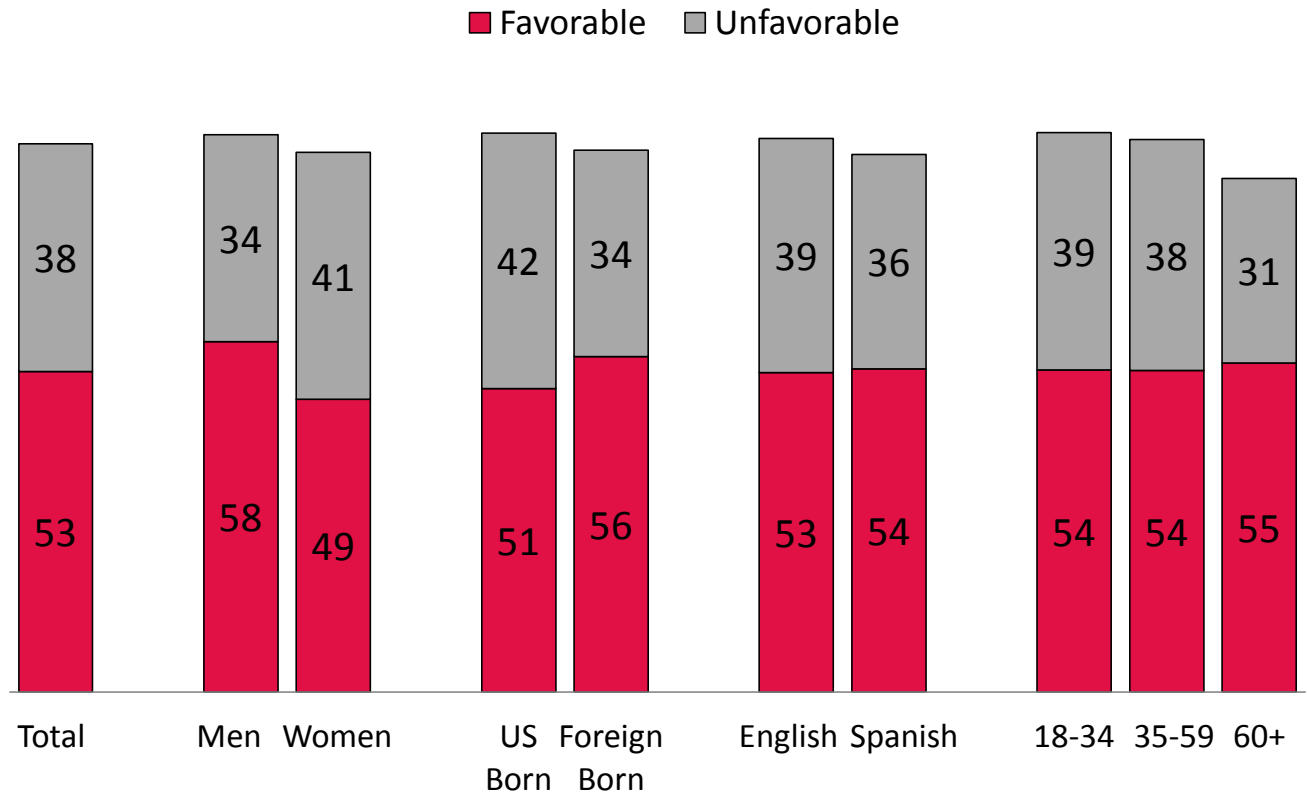

State Immigration Policy Environment

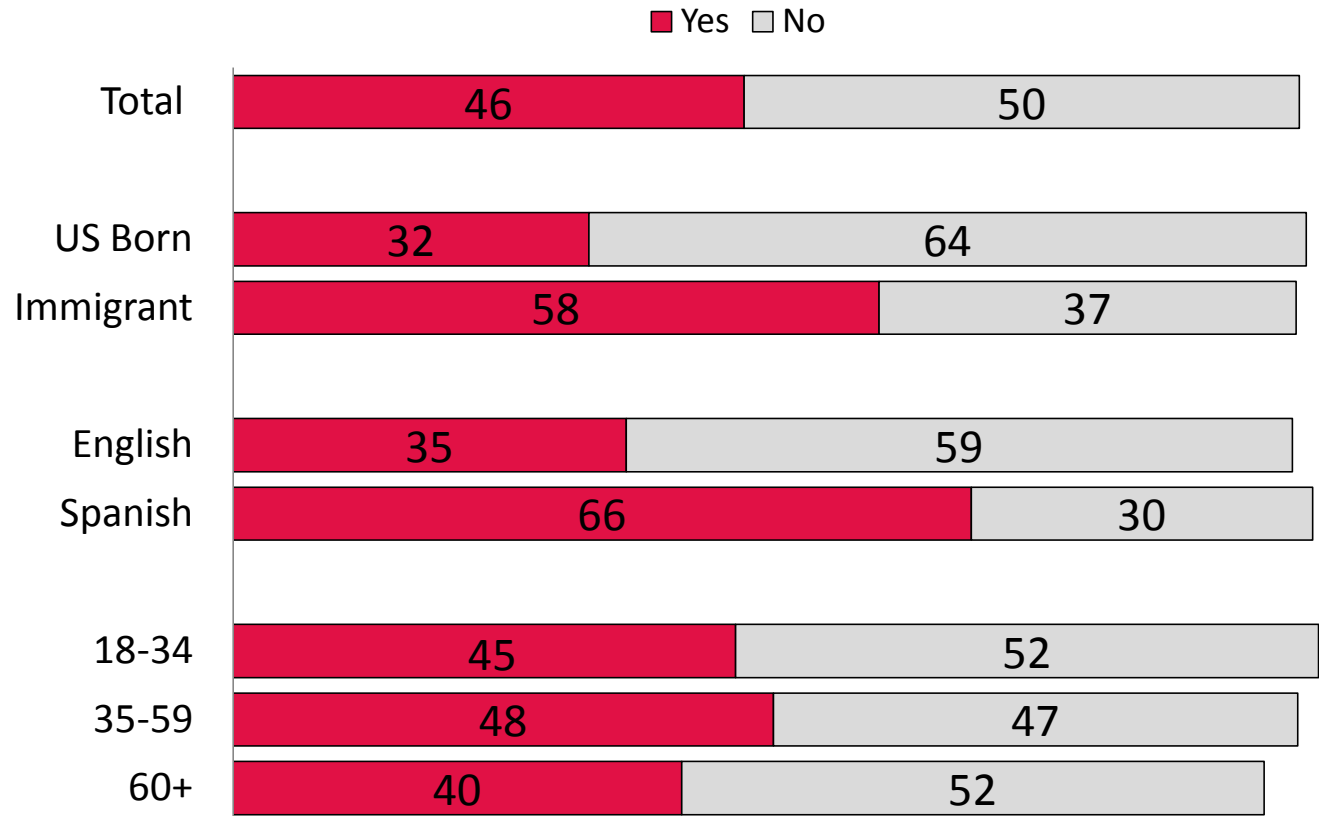
Thinking about the immigrant population in your state, would you describe your state's policies as favorable or unfavorable towards immigrants?

Do you worry that your friends or family members might be detained or deported due to their immigration status?

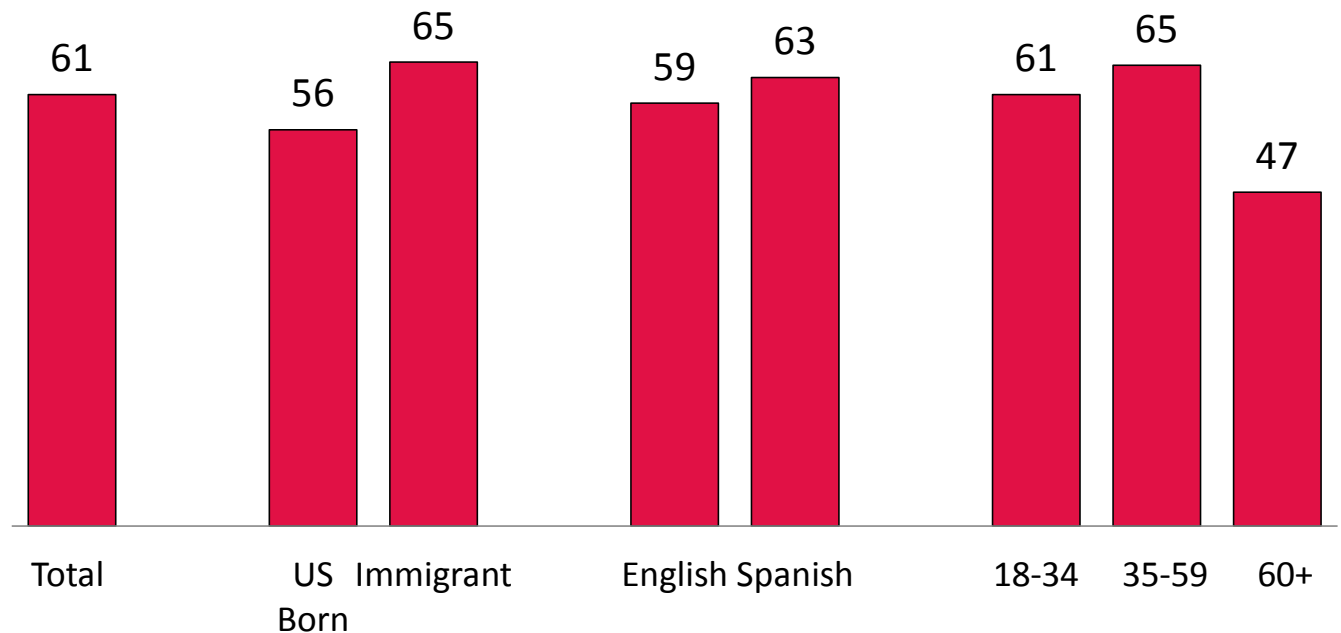

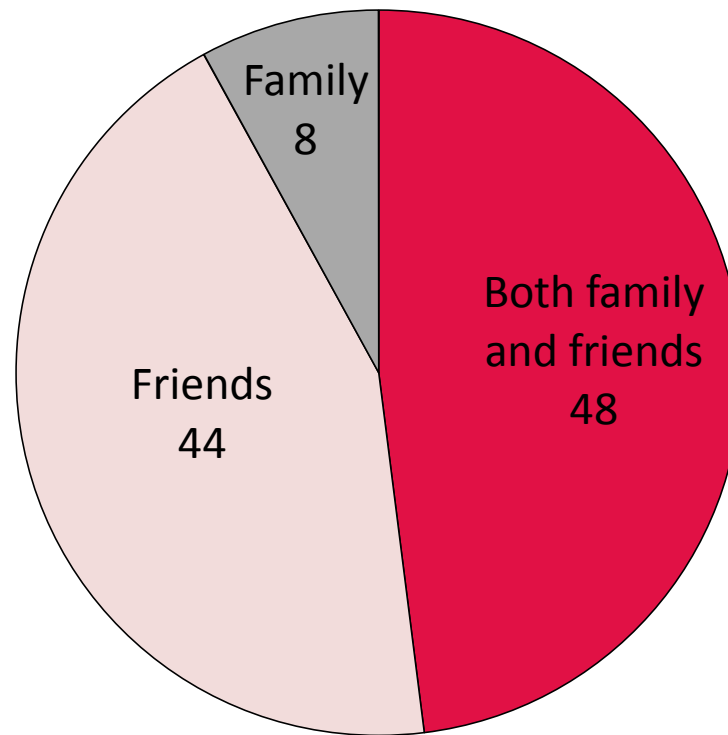

Is that a family member or a friend, who is undocumented, or do you know both?

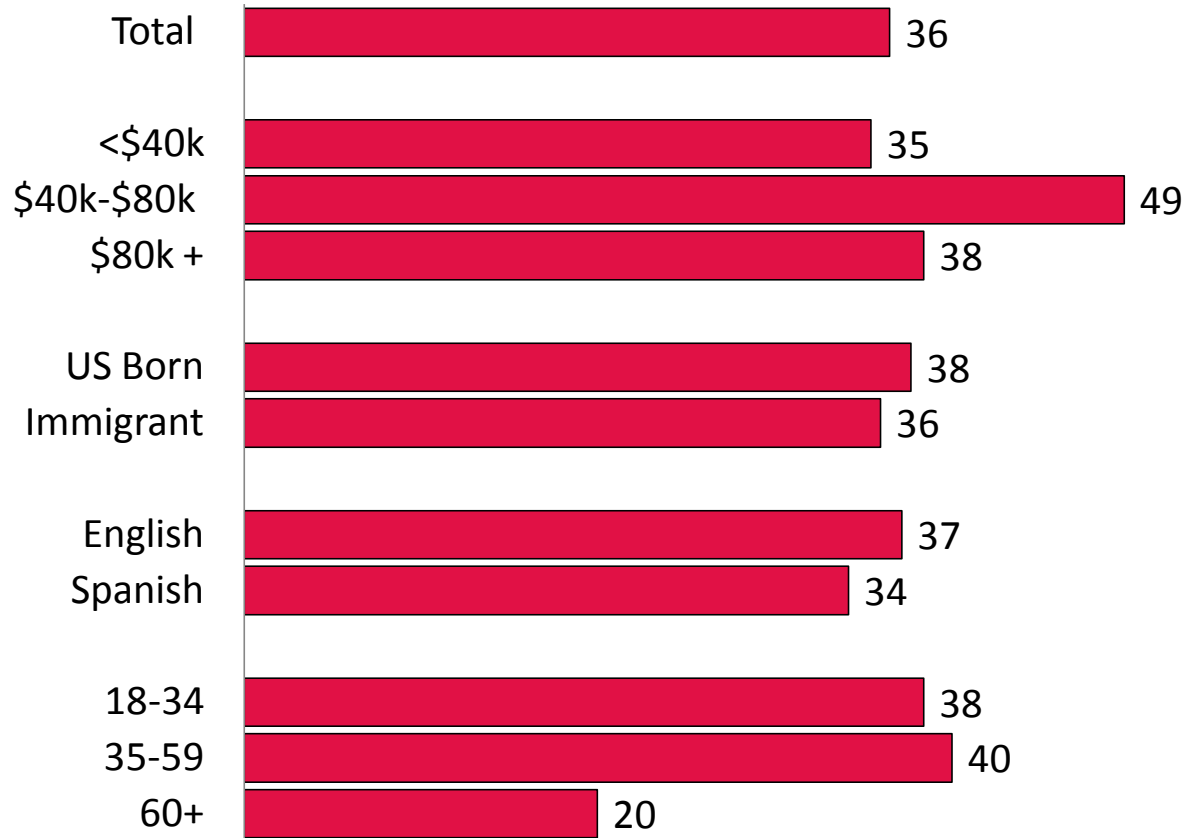

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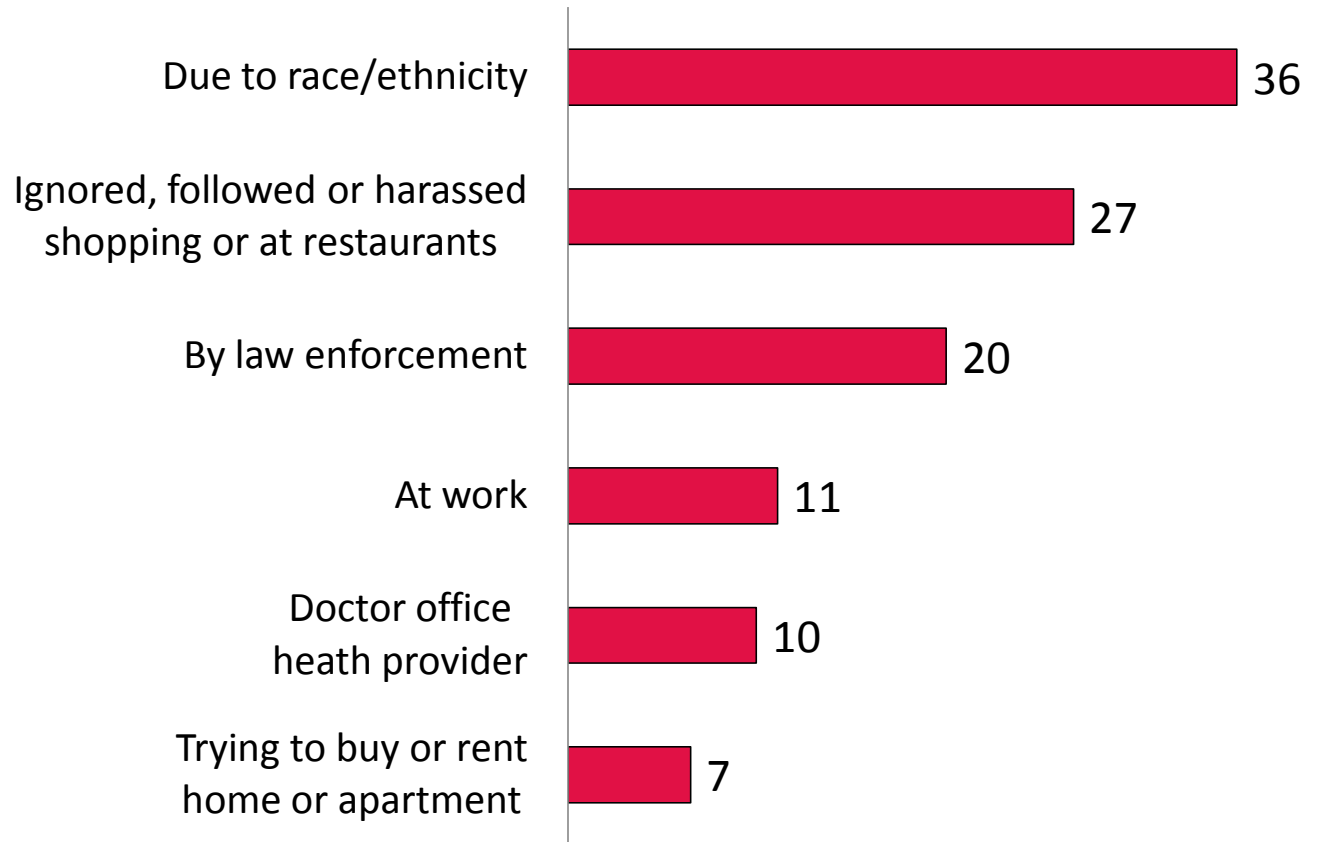
